News from the Committee of Management (CoM)

Recently at CoM meetings there has been much discussion on what the future needs are for tennis facilities and what people are expecting and looking for. We are rated by Tennis NSW as a premier community tennis centre, of which there are only a few currently in the Sydney metropolitan area. After a deal of discussion, including with Tennis NSW and Hornsby Council, we have agreed as a CoM that we will consider a development project that will possibly see an updated modern two storey sustainable club house that will give the Association facilities to meet current and future needs. The discussions have centred around our current aging but well-maintained club facilities to be added to through a new building sitting beside it to provide:

- 1. meeting and facilities for various tennis and community needs, for example, our coaching partners, pro shop staff, other sports within the park and other community agencies
- 2. social areas for a cup of coffee to a gathering of friends in comfortable surroundings
- 3. viewing area across the main courts
- 4. increased space providing shade and also protection from rain
- 5. additional toilet facilities to meet the needs, including those for disabled people
- 6. development of sustainable environmentally friendly options, for example solar power, car charging points
- 7. increased space for storage needs and additional community assets
- 8. and many more advantages!

We would like to connect with you as the members for what you would like the future to look like for the Association.


