Colin Baker Cup

On the 17th of November 1923, the Midson Road Epping courts were opened marking the beginning of Eastwood Thornleigh District Tennis Association. Exactly 100 years later, I held the Colin Baker Cup to commemorate the centenary and celebrate the contributions of our now retired Friday Night Midson Road Social coordinator Colin Baker (pictured below).

When I first met Colin in 2019, he welcomed my friends and I into the Friday social he organised. Colin had been in the Friday social since 1968, with the group itself beginning in 1949. Colin worked diligently to welcome new players each week and laid the groundwork for a successful social built on the values of friendliness and tennis with good sportsmanship. Although Colin retired from running the social in mid-2020, it is the continuation of the spirit of the social that has allowed our social to grow considerably, post pandemic.

The Colin Baker Cup was well attended with 7 teams and 14 players vying for the Cup and a small audience celebrating the centenary of tennis. The festivities included cakes baked by club president Kaye McIntyre. The winners Alan and Peter (pictured with Colin Baker) decisively won the Cup, with the distinctive combination of Alan's signature serve and volley and Peter's reliable counterpunching.

Peg travelled to many tournaments over the years within Australia and overseas. She represented NSW as a Junior, won many Australian and World Seniors titles, and played over 9 times in the Friendship cup representing Australia in different age categories and won at least 8 World titles on the way.

Peg has played at Hills and Eastwood Thornleigh Associations for over 50 years and has told us how much fun she had during those years and the incredible friendships forged on the way.

Peg is certainly not a wall flower when it comes to competing and was still winning lots of games with her ball skills and strategic play right up to her recent tennis retirement. If it wasn't for her ankle injury Peg would definitely still be playing to this day. Peg has just loved playing and was so disappointed giving up competition play at 89. Wow if we could be so lucky to have her incredible zest for life and still be as competitive and giving us all a run for our money.

Peg is our matriarch, our coach, our advisor and all things tennis. She still comes to tennis every week to our Tuesday ladies to watch and acts as a great mentor to us all on the way showing us her joy for the game at every turn. We are so in awe of her many accomplishments doing something she just loves.
