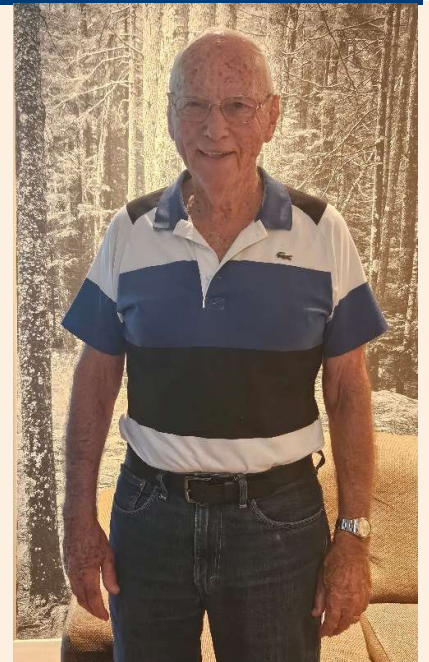
# Thank you to our Outgoing Committee!

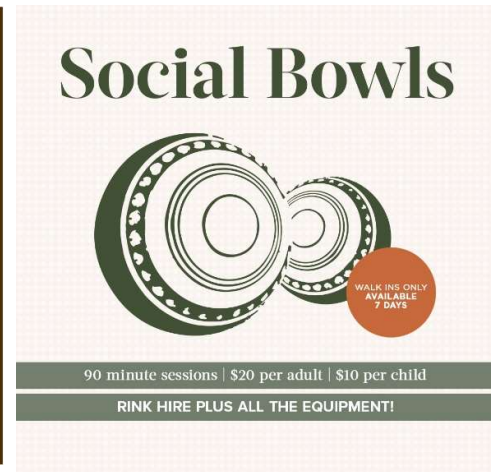
