

Unfortunately, the la Nina weather patterns this summer has meant that many of our competitions have been disrupted by wet weather and occasional power outages.

Whilst this may be frustrating, it is not acceptable to take this frustration out on Pro Shop staff or the competition secretaries who volunteer their time to organise and run our competitions. Please report matter of concern with regards to court, grounds, and light issues to Pro Shop staff, politely. They will source the appropriate technician. Again, please refrain from using a hostile manner.

We update the weather news based on current court conditions. No forecasting takes place and we can't make an early decision based on your location from courts or if you wish to make social plans.

If matches are washed out, please don't ask the Pro Shop for a refund. Our competition ByLaws state that if more than 50% of the matches haven't completed the first set due to rain or another issue, then the match will be rescheduled for another date.

Recently we hosted an emergency defibrillator training session for our members, and committee members. This was to allow people refresh themselves with the proceedings of such equipment.

Our centre has an AED located within the main clubhouse as well as outside of court 12 clubhouse. At Epping Court, Midson Rd, the AED is located within the clubhouse. The defibrillators we have bought are semiautomated and the instructions to talk you through the procedure display on the front screen when activated.

Tennis Ball Recycling



Did you know that an estimated 10 million tennis balls are purchased in Australia each year?

Unfortunately, at the end of their useful lives, all of them end up either in landfills or in our waterways, eventually working their way into the ocean.

To address this environmental concern, we have partnered with Game On Recycling to collect and recycle tennis balls. From now on, you can dispose your unwanted and unloved tennis balls in the collection unit near the Pro Shop.

Collected tennis balls are granulated into 5mm pieces and used in a variety of manufacturing processes including the production of soft fall matting. All recycling and downstream processing will be undertaken in Australia. Game On Recycling is also conducting research to explore new uses for these materials (like a rubberised sporting surface).

Stay safe with a skin check

Did you know skin cancer causes more deaths than <u>motor vehicle accident?</u> The risk of getting skin cancer is higher in men than in women – 67% if Australians who die from <u>ski cancer are men</u>. It's recommended that you get a check done every 6 months or annually at the very least. Here why.

What is skin cancer?

Skin cancer is primarily caused by overexposure to ultraviolet (UV) radiation from the sun, which causes <u>DNA damage to skin cells</u>. If this damage is too severe and the body is not able to repair it, then faulty cell replication occurs, triggering the growth of abnormal cells that eventually become cancerous.

Get regular skin checks

Staying sun smart and getting skin checks is the best way to stay protected against the risks of getting skin cancer. Most health insurance providers cover all or part of one annual skin cancer screening.

Check your skin at home

Get to know your skin with regular self-checks to maximise your chances of detecting skin cancer early. Look for spots or moles that are:

- Sore a spot that is sore and doesn't heal six weeks
- Changing in appearance (size, shape, colour or texture)
- Abnormal looks or feels different, stands out form other spots and moles
- New spots that have appeared recently

Am I at risk of skin cancer?

Everyone may have some risk of getting skin cancer especially if you're not being sun smart. This risk also increases as you grow older. Your more at risk of getting skin cancer if you:

- Have family history of skin cancer
- Are particularly prone to sunburn
- Have fair skin or have moles on your skin
- Spend a lot of time outdoors without sun protection
- Have a compromised immune system



History Unveiled

This handbook from the 1933-34 season of ETDTA is the earliest published record that we have. Not only does it show the allimportant draw, but you can delve into the constitution for some night-time reading check out where you can get your hair cut, or where to pick up a sandwich or a sausage or two on the way home!

Most teams in the competition played on a court located at a player's home. That changed in the latter part of the 20th century when property values changed and people subdivided and sold off the court for housing, leading to the building of Pennant Hills Park Tennis Centre.
