Thirty years ago, CMRI created 'Jeans for Genes' Day to raise awareness about the 1 in every 20 children born with a genetic disease or birth defect, and to raise funds to launch its gene therapy research program.

Today, we celebrate the successes of gene therapy in treating and effectively curing kids of formerly fatal conditions, while acknowledging there are still many more diseases to be solved.

This tennis tournament is being held to raise funds for CMRI, with 100% of the funds raised to go to research in the Stem Cell Medicine Group at CMRI to find treatments and cures that can help individuals living with an inherited retinal disease - the leading cause of blindness in working-aged adults in Australia.

Please join us for a day of tennis, good food, and to hear how our researchers are developing treatments for inherited retinal diseases. With your support, we hope to raise over \$10,000 for CMRI and promote greater awareness about inherited retinal diseases.

# The story behind our court names...

Have you ever wondered, when you look up the draw to see who your opposition is, what is the origin of their team name, i.e. their court name?

The courts at PHPTC are named after native plants, animals, and in the case of Mulduri, it is the Yaraldi Aboriginal word for magpie. Arunta is named after a cicada but it is also the name of a group of Central Australian Aboriginal people living around Alice Springs. One of their most well known members was Albert Namatjira.

Boronia is a small shrub, known for its perfumed flowers. Waratahs range from flowering shrubs to trees, and is the floral emblem of NSW. Banksias are in the same family as Waratahs and also range from shrub to tree. Acacia is our symbol of spring, the wattle tree. Brigalow is also a type of wattle. Koala needs no explanation, nor does Currawong, that predatory black and white 'rain' bird. A wallaroo is similar to but smaller than a kangaroo. Rosellas are colourful small parrots and many of the crimson rosellas feed and breed around PHPTC.

Bunderra is Wallaby Grass, a native perennial. Wilga is a drought resistant tree with white flowers. Many farmers cut its branches to feed their stock during drought. Coolabah is a type of eucalyptus, Tristania is the myrtle tree. Telopea is also a large flowering plant.

Midson Road courts have had their names for much longer than those at PHPTC as that centre has been in existence for much longer. I have no idea of the system behind the nomenclature, but Frenesi is great excitement or wild behaviour (frenzy?), Carioca is a resident of Rio de Janiero or a Brazilian dance, and Challenge is what tennis is! On that note I finish.






