Tennis Ball and Racquet Recycling

Did you know that an estimated 10 million tennis balls are purchased in Australia each year?

Unfortunately, at the end of their useful lives, all of them end up either in landfills or in our waterways, eventually working their way into the ocean. To address this environmental concern, we have partnered with Game On Recycling to collect and recycle tennis balls. From now on, you can dispose your unwanted and unloved tennis balls in the collection unit near the Pro Shop. Collected tennis balls are granulated into 5mm pieces and used in a variety of manufacturing processes including the production of soft fall matting. All recycling and downstream processing will be undertaken in Australia. Game On Recycling is also conducting research to explore new uses for these materials (like a rubberised sporting surface).
